



## 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION VOTER GUIDE

Our research team has reviewed the California races that affect Ventura County and Western Los Angeles County for the PRIMARY ELECTION ONLY. Some candidates will only be seen on ballots if your designation is for that party. For example, ONLY Republicans can vote for Republican Central Committee or a Republican President.

It is not too late to register or change party registration as California will allow it up to the day of election. Go to <https://registertovote.ca.gov/> if you don't want to be left out of critical voting choices.

**STATE ASSEMBLY & STATE SENATE** create the laws, and Newsom signs them. If you don't like the laws, or the direction of California, then make a change in these positions. Currently, there is a Super Majority of Democrats so they are solely running our state. It would be best to vote in many Republicans (or Independents) to avoid the Super Majority overriding scenario.

**CENTRAL COMMITTEE** is for county level party leadership. They are responsible for recruiting, training, fundraising, and expanding party registrations. If you think the party is not doing well, change is made in these positions.

**US CONGRESS** positions are in Washington DC and also called the "House". If you don't like the way the country is being led, make changes in this position. They create/approve the budget for the Government.

**US SENATE** are in Washington DC and approve laws created by the House, plus solely responsible for approving judges. There are two Senators per state.

A **PROPOSITION** is generated by a group of people to make a change within a city, county or the state levels. Many times the text misleads the reader on what the end result will be. For example, The State put a proposition to make the roads better for police / fire to get to your homes faster. In reality, it was just a gas tax.
